Entry into the Selective Stream Year 7



- Placement is administered by the High Performing Students Unit.
- Placement is offered based on academic merit and the order of school choices.
- Students' academic merit is judged based on reading, writing, mathematics and general ability as demonstrated in the Selective High School Placement Test, and primary school assessments in English and Mathematics.

Entry into the Selective Stream Year 7



- Applicants can choose up to three selective schools in their application.
- Balmain Campus has a selection committee which makes decisions about placements.
- To finalise enrolment you must have received an Authority to attend letter from the high performing students unit, and be able to provide proof of Australian permanent residency or citizenship of Australia or New Zealand.

Selection Committees



- Place applicants for that school in order of their calculated placement scores
- Look at the likely impact of disability and illness/ misadventure requests
- Give priority to isolated students who apply for boarding at agricultural high schools
- Consider matters affecting students outside the age or school year
- Give consideration to students who are Aboriginal or who have been educated in English for less than 48 months
- Look at other evidence of academic merit if necessary
- List students for offers and reserve places according to the number of vacancies at the school
- Consider any other relevant factors brought to their attention.

Key dates for Year 7 Selective placement 2023:

- Tuesday 19 October 2021 Application website opens
- Wednesday 17 November 2021 Application website closes. You must apply by the due date.
- Thursday 10 March 2022 Selective High School Placement Test
- Early July 2022- Placement outcome information is expected to be released

Purpose of Enrichment



- Enrichment is a unique opportunity for our students to extend their giftedness and talents.
- The experiences of these opportunities will enable each student to be extended across academic, creative and athletic areas but also to pursue their individual talent or area of excellence with guidance and mentoring.



Academic Enrichment Class



- Students are placed in the Academic Enrichment class based on academic merit in areas such as English, Science, History, Geography, LOTE, Mathematics and Technology.
- In year 7 students are placed according to an academic assessment and portfolio. The focus of the class is on embedding the use of emerging technologies while providing real world, project based learning opportunities that enrich and extend the students.

Creativity Enrichment Class



- Students are placed in the Creativity Enrichment Class based on the demonstration of a talent and interest in Visual Arts, Drama, Music and Design.
- The school will provide an enriched creative and performing arts program leading to enhanced learning outcomes, developing and enhancing student's current skills and exhibiting their work both in school and the wider community.

Talented Athlete Program



- The Talented Athlete Program is aimed at talented sports people.
- The program delivers opportunities for students to develop skills related to their sport, fitness training, monitoring of development, nutritional and motivational sessions with opportunities for students to participate in representative sport at all levels.
- Students are required to attend before school training sessions as part of this program.
- Selective students can apply.
